My name is Ms. Laughlin, and I am excited to tell you about a new opportunity that your student is eligible to participate in. The NW Learning Hub is partnering with GTCC to offer Virtual Community College courses this Spring **free of charge!** Students can complete their coursework during Learning Hub (after school on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 4:30-6pm) while receiving support from Learning Hub staff. Below is an overview of participation requirements, courses offered, and registration steps.

Requirements-

- Student must be a high school Junior or Senior
- Cumulative unweighted GPA of 2.8 or higher

Admissions Sessions are required for all new students. Because of COVID-19, the recorded Admissions Session below replaces the required Admissions Meeting. Please submit a completed application packet, with all signatures, after viewing the Admissions Session.

The Admissions Session includes information on the following:

- General Program Information; Curriculum Pathways; How to navigate the website to search for classes; How to register for classes; Q & A

Once you and your parent have viewed the Admissions Session:

1. **Determine your Career and College Promise Pathway** – Write the Pathway name and Code on your Verification Form.

There are two types of Career and College Promise Pathways:

- **College Transfer Pathways** – GTCC offers nine different college transfer pathways
- **Career/Technical Education Pathways** – GTCC offers numerous certificate and diploma programs.

2. **Complete the Online Application for CCP:** Follow this

You will need to create an account on CFNC.org.

3. Once you have completed the online application, scan your additional application documents and email to ccp@gtcc.edu.

Do not copy and paste the documents into the body of the email. Please use the "attach" command.

- **Verification of Student Eligibility Form** – Please make sure that you have all required signatures and that you have included the pathway. Signatures may be obtained by email.
- **Attendance Policy Form**
- **Consent to Release Form** – to be completed by the student.
- **Media Release Form** – to be completed by the parent.
- **Year-End High School Transcript** – Please send a copy of your latest transcript with the admissions packet. *If you attend a public high school, you may request this through cfn.org. Please provide your High School ID # on the Verification Form. If your transcript is in a sealed envelope, you may open it and scan it.* For home school transcripts - courses must be listed by grade level, signed and dated by principal and include a cumulative unweighted GPA.
- **Copy of Home School State Registration** (if applicable)

4. Once you have submitted your application documents:

1. Please keep checking the email listed on your application. If something is missing, you will be notified. After the application is processed, the applicant will receive an email with Titan Account Activation Instructions.
2. After activating your Titan account, please log into your GTCC Titan Email and check it frequently. Registration instructions will be sent to your Titan email only.
3. Once you have registered for classes, you will be sent an email with instructions for our mandatory online CCP Orientation.
