

SEHS SLT Minutes

5.7.2024

The meeting commenced at **8:15am** in room 111.

Copies of the April meeting minutes were reviewed and approved.

Old Business

Jamie Davis provided an update on the work surrounding the 2024-25 matrix. Currently, we have reviewed what department chairs submitted and made necessary adjustments. We hope to “spin” the matrix during the week May 13-17 and make additional adjustments as needed. Following this timeline, departments will have a matrix before they leave June 7.

While SLT supports the reinstatement of senior privileges, they want to ensure they are motivating for Seniors. With this in mind, Aniya Coleman will speak with SGA and Mr. Scott and will bring back suggestions for SLT approval at the summer meeting.

SLT would like for the English Department to move forward with a schoolwide reading program/initiative and let each department know how they can support this work. Scott did share that in conversations with students they wanted to choose what they read (opposed to a one school one book type idea). Students also recommended a summer hashtag where kids could post via social media what they are reading and where they were geographically.

New Business

[Results from the 2024 Teacher Working Conditions Survey](#) have been released. SLT reviewed these items and Scott pointed out items that were low and how we can address those. Ultimately, the subcommittee formed earlier this year will reconvene to thoroughly review the data and provide SLT with some action steps. The subcommittee includes Currie, Mitcham, Vega, Davis and Rich.

Each department needs to review their leadership positions before the end of the school year. Jamie Davis will follow up with SLT reps and department chairs. To ensure there is not complete turnover in leadership within a department, terms are staggered. These are the leadership positions within each department that need to be reviewed.
