The Guilford County Chapter of PAGE (Partners for the Advancement of Gifted Education), established in 2013, a 501(c)3 non-profit affiliate of NCAGT (North Carolina Association of the Gifted and Talented) is relaunching after the pandemic hiatus by rebuilding their membership, rewriting the nickname of PAGE, and reenergizing the chapter board.
