

Lifestyles Referral Form: Rule 24 Violation

Guilford County Schools' Health Services and Nursing Department coordinates the Lifestyles Program, an alternative to suspension program for high school students who violate Rule 24. GCS Health Services and Nursing contracts with Alcohol and Drug Services (ADS) to teach the Lifestyles classes. Please follow these procedures to enroll students in the Lifestyles Program:

- **Administrator or designee** must send completed and **password protected** form to Kimberly Fields at fieldsk2@gcsnc.com.
- **Administrator or designee** should send form even if student declines participation in the program.
- **Parent/Guardian of high school students must contact Aileen Vazquez (ADS) at (336) 501-1373.**
- Contact must be made within three (3) school days of signing this form to schedule an appointment to be evaluated and placed in the program.
