SCHOOL INFORMATION

- Our school day is from 9:15am-4:15pm.
- Weaver Academy is on a block schedule. Each class is 90 minutes long. Students take 4 classes from August-January (first semester) and take 4 different classes from January-June (second semester), for a total of 8 classes per year.

ACADEMIC CURRICULUM

- The Guilford County Schools math sequence is I, II, and III.
- Some of Weaver's course sequences in other areas may differ from other schools. For example, we teach Biology in 9th grade, but some schools teach Earth/Environmental Science in 9th grade.
- Our Health/Physical Education classes are taught at the Bryan Family YMCA by Weaver faculty.
- AP Courses are usually taken in grades 10, 11, and 12. The following AP Courses are currently taught: AP English Language, AP English Literature, AP World History, AP U.S. History, AP Psychology, AP Statistics, AP Calculus, AP Environmental Science, AP Music Theory, AP Art 2-D, AP Art Drawing, and AP Computer Science Principles.
- Honors Courses include: Honors English I, Honors English II, Honors English III, Honors English IV, Honors Spanish III, Honors Math I, Honors Math II, Honors Math III, Honors IV, Honors Pre-Calculus, Honors Discrete Math for Computer Science, Honors World History, Honors Civic Literacy, Honors American History, Honors Economics & Personal Finance, Honors Biology, Honors Chemistry, Honors Environmental Science, and Honors Anatomy/Physiology.
- Academic teachers at Weaver Academy offer free tutoring to students. Schedules are provided by each teacher at the beginning of each semester. There is also an active peer tutoring program which is coordinated through the Counseling Office.

GRADUATION

- Weaver Academy has achieved 100% Graduation Rate for every graduating class since our first graduates in 2006.
- Students at Weaver Academy must have 28 credits to graduate. Each class counts as 1 credit.
- Academic Requirements include:
 - English I, II, III, IV
 - 4 math credits, including at least one above Math III
 - Social Studies: Civic Literacy, World History, American History, Economics & Personal Finance
 - Science: Biology, Chemistry, Earth/Environmental Science
 - Health/Physical Education
 - Foreign Language: 2 credits in the same language (required for 4-year college). Spanish I, II, and III are offered at Weaver.
- Students are required to successfully meet a CPR Proficiency Requirement.
- Students also take required performing/visual art classes within their principle area.

POST-SECONDARY INFORMATION

- The Class of 2022 was offered over \$6.0 million in scholarship awards.
- Weaver graduates have attended most of the public and independent colleges and universities in North Carolina. Graduates have studied in 32 of the 50 states, as well as Washington, D.C. Others have journeyed to the United Kingdom, Scotland, England, Wales, and Canada for post-secondary education. The Armed Services have also been chosen by Weaver graduates.

DRIVER'S EDUCATION

- Classes are offered once or twice a year; either the Fall, Spring, and/or Summer at Weaver. During the school year, classes are after school. Summer sessions are held daily for a shorter period. Students may also take Driver's Ed at other GCS high schools or private agencies, if their schedule does not fit with the classes offered at Weaver.
