What does the PVA abbreviation represent? Performing and Visual Arts

What is a “principle area” or an “arts area” or “discipline” or “craft”? Each of these terms refer to the area of program to which you are applying. The terms are used interchangeably by faculty and students. Weaver has eight programs – dance, classical guitar, recording engineering (music production), piano, orchestral strings, theatre, visual art, vocal music.

Where is the main entrance located? The main entrance is located on the back side of the campus, adjacent to Greensboro College, and is accessible from West Market, Cedar, and McGee streets. There is a circle drive for student drop-off and pick-up. The four glass doors are the main entrance. Other doors are secured and not available for entering the building.

Where do applicants go once inside the building? Applicants will be greeted by a Student Ambassador and/or faculty member and directed to the registration area. Student Ambassadors will escort applicants to the appropriate waiting and/or practice areas.

What do applicants bring to the audition? A copy of the most recent report card should be brought to registration. Additional items may be required and are listed in the Audition Requirements (posted on the Weaver Academy website). Theatre resumés, music production items, art portfolios, sheet music, etc., should be kept by the applicant until called for their audition.

What do parents/guardians do during auditions? Parents/guardians and guests may leave campus during the audition or remain in their vehicle in the parking area. Parents/guardians and guests are not allowed in the building. (If an applicant needs to call someone when their audition is complete, a telephone is available.)

Where do families park if they remain on campus during the audition? There is a large parking area behind the building. From South Spring Street, turn RIGHT onto McGee Street. At the second drive, turn RIGHT. Vehicles should not park in marked spaces.

What happens after the audition? From the GCS website: Families will receive notification of High School Choice Schools & Programs seat offers on April 21, 2023. Notifications will be communicated by email or text according to the notification method selected when families set up their account. Families must accept or decline offers by April 28, 2023. Once a family has accepted an offer from one of our Choice Schools & Programs, they will receive a link to request transportation and information from the school to complete the enrollment and registration process.
