

Scholarships (December 2022)

The Burger King Scholars Program offers scholarships to seniors who have a minimum GPA of 2.0 and plan to enroll at an accredited 2-or 4-year school. Amounts range from \$1,000 to \$50,000. More information at <https://burgerking.scholarsapply.org/information.php>. Deadline is **December 15**.

The Equitable Excellence Scholarship is available to students nationwide. Amounts range from \$2,500-\$5,000.
