

**Parking for Weaver Academy is not allowed in the YMCA parking lot.** There is an attendant on duty the entire day so vehicles parked at the YMCA **risk being towed.** **Weaver's main parking lot is located off McGee Street.**

Parking permits are required for all vehicles parked on the Weaver Academy campus. All vehicles are required to display a valid school-parking sticker on the vehicle's front lower left windshield or another high school permit that has been registered at Weaver Academy.
