## Early and Middle Colleges Prepare High Schoolers for Success

## GCS HAS A TRACK RECORD OF FINDING INNOVATIVE WAYS TO HELP STUDENTS SOAR TO GREATNESS,

including being a national leader in offering early and middle college opportunities to students who want to get a jump start on their college experiences or those who may not be considering college as an option after high school. Research shows students who participate in dual-enrollment programs are more likely to go on and get a college degree.

GCS started North Carolina's first middle college at Greensboro College and the state's first early college high school at Guilford College. Now, GCS offers nine early and middle colleges on eight different college campuses. All give students the opportunity to graduate high school with up to two years of college credit without paying a dime in tuition.

Four middle colleges also offer students the chance to earn their associate degree while still in high school.
