EASTERN GUILFORD HIGH SCHOOL ATHLETIC BOOSTER CLUB SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

The EGHS Athletic Booster Club, Inc. will award a \$500 scholarship to at least one qualifying senior male and senior female athlete each year. With proof of enrollment, payment will be sent to the college or university of the recipients' choice by September 30, of the recipients' first semester of study. If the recipient does not attend an institute of higher learning in the fall following graduation, the scholarship will be held in the form of a bank CD for one year. After this period of time, if the recipient chooses not to attend a college or university, the scholarship money will be forfeited.

The scholarship recipient will be chosen by the Board of Directors of the EGHS Athletic Booster Club, Inc.. In the event a child or relative of the Board of Directors applies for this scholarship, the board member(s) will not be a part of the decision making body. If one-third (1/3) of the Board of Directors are not able to participate in making the decision of the scholarship recipient (due to their exclusion as a result of family ties); a substitute selection committee will be formed.

The formal presentation of the scholarship award will be made at the Senior Sports Banquet.

CRITERIA FOR THE AWARD

- 1. At the time of the application, the applicant must not have failed any subjects taken the previous semester and all subjects currently being taken must have a passing grade.
- 2. The applicant must have earned an athletic letter in at least one varsity sport.
- 3. The applicant must have an overall GPA of at least 3.0.
- 4. The applicant must submit three sealed letters of recommendation that should cite good citizenship, character, and acts of volunteer service along with their opinion as to why the applicant is a good choice for this award:
 - a) One from an EGHS faculty member
 - b) One from an EGHS coach
 - c) One from a non-family member / non EGHS staff member
- 5. Each applicant must submit a 250 word (doubled-spaced) essay stating his/her reason(s) for applying for this scholarship. Include in the essay any specific example(s) of extracurricular activities/clubs/community organizations in which he/she is involved; along with reason(s) why he/she would be the best choice for this award.

t is the applicant's responsibility to submit a 100% completed packet to Ms. Carol King by May, of the application year. (If May, 1 falls on a weekend, the deadline will be the next day school s in session)
